
General Announcements

The Miracle of Cana

Meditation

The newlyweds of Cana are certainly relatives or friends of Jesus and His Mother. Middle Eastern hospitality being what it is, Jesus very easily has His five companions included in the invitation.¹ Weddings among the Jews sometimes went on for an entire week. When Our Lord arrives, the celebration is already well underway. The coming of the new guests and especially of Jesus, who was so close to the couple, certainly fills the hosts and all their guests with joy. But soon the wine begins to fail, so quickly that a slight wave of uneasiness enters the wedding hall. The Blessed Virgin, with her feminine intuition, quickly sees the reason for the anxiety in the air. And so, to spare the young couple and their guests from such an embarrassment, she goes up to Our Lord and simply says to Him, "They have no wine." (Jn. 2:3)

There are six urns, or *amphorae*, in the hall, of a kind still to be found in the Middle East and used for carrying water or for keeping a supply of it at home, depending on the size.

Our Lord is not miserly with His gifts. When He works a miracle, He does not do anything by halves. He is going to transform 300 gallons of water into particularly exquisite wine.

So the servants obey. They fill the jars to the brim with water and then draw out a sample finding now not water but a most delectable wine, far superior to what was being served before. The difference is so striking that the chief steward sees fit to make a comment to the host. Like Jesus and Mary, let us do our best to save those around us from embarrassment when they are going through difficulties and certainly not complicate their troubles even more.

O my Jesus, help me to be kind and to practice an attentive charity toward the people around me, so that I might one day be shown to my place at the heavenly banquet of eternal bliss.

- 2 To give alms to a beggar or say three *Ave*'s for him.
- 3 Take the time to listen to and console a person who is suffering.
