Meditation

While slaves of the Egyptians, the Hebrews begged for a liberator, and God raised up Moses to lead them to the promised land. But it took the ten plagues of Egypt, the last of which was the death of the firstborn of the Egyptians, to win the consent of the pharaoh to let them go. While the firstborn of the Hebrews were protected by the blood of the lamb smeared on the lintel of the doors of their houses, the firstborn of the Egyptians were exterminated by the angel of God. Since then, in thanksgiving for this special protection of God, the Hebrews made the offering of their eldest sons, according to what is written in the Book of Numbers: "The Lord spoke to Moses, saying: The day on which I slew every firstborn in the land of Egypt, I consecrated to Myself all the firstborn of Israel" (based on Exodus 13:1-2 and 15).

It is therefore with dispositions of obedience and thanksgiving that Our Lady submitted to this law today. Of course, she did not wait for that day to offer her Son to God interiorly. She already offered Him from the day of the conception of Jesus in her womb. But today she expressed in a visible way the interior state of her soul.

In an act of unprecedented magnanimity, she offered Our Lord to God His Father. And she offered Him not only as an individual, as a simple Israelite,

but as Head of the future mystical body which is the Church. As a result, we are already present at this offering. It is not an exaggeration to think that if offering her divine Son for the salvation of the world, Our Lady is already thinking of all the souls who will benefit from the fruits of His Passion.

Through this offering, made with such beautiful dispositions, she perfectly met God's expectation. Today, as on the day of the Annunciation, she renewed her *Fiat*: "Be it done to me according to Thy word" (Lk. 1:38). At this offering was when the old man Simeon announced that her Son would be "a sign of contradiction" (Lk. 2:34) and, as for Our Lady, a "two-edged sword of sorrow shall pierce her soul" (Lk. 2:35).
